## What is this product?

### TYPE

The product is a sub-fund of Aliter Investors, an Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) incorporated as a variable capital investment company (SICAV) under the laws of Luxembourg.

### TERM

The Fund is established for an unlimited duration. However the Board of Directors may decide to close this product under certain circumstances.

### OBJECTIVES

To generate returns exceeding the MSCI World (dividend reinvested) Index over a recommended investment horizon of at least 5 years, by primarily investing in listed companies with a significant positive social impact.

The Sub-Fund invests primarily in equities from around the world, mainly in the field of developed markets composing the MSCI World (dividend reinvested) Index.

The Sub-Fund may invest up to 10% of the net assets in UCITS/UCIs in equities securities selected for their social or environmental dimension. This upper limit also applies to investments in money market UCITS/UCIs.

The Sub-Fund may hold Ancillary Liquid Assets (up to 20% of its net assets) in order to cover current or exceptional payments or for the time necessary to reinvest those Ancillary Liquid Assets in eligible assets provided under Chapter 3.4 "Investment Restrictions" of the prospectus or for a time strictly necessary in case of unfavourable market conditions to preserve the Shareholders' capital and invest such Ancillary Liquid Assets when better investment opportunities arise. This 20% limit could be temporarily breached for a period of time strictly necessary when, because of exceptional unfavourable market conditions, circumstances so require and where such breach is justified having regard to the interests of the Shareholders.

Derivatives are integral to the Sub-Fund's investment strategies. The Sub-Fund may use derivatives for hedging.

These shares are capitalisation shares. Income and capital gains are reinvested.

### INTENDED RETAIL INVESTOR

The product is suitable for investors with a long-term investment horizon (minimum 5 years). The product is compatible with investors who may bear capital losses and who do not need capital guarantee. The product is compatible with clients looking for growing their capital and who wish to hold their investment over 5 years.

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

### Risk indicator



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years.

## What happens if FundSight S.A. is unable to pay out?

FundSight S.A. is not making any payment to you in relation to this Fund and you would still be paid in case of a default from FundSight S.A.

The Sub-Fund's assets are held with CACEIS Bank Luxembourg S.A. and are segregated from the assets of other sub-funds of the Fund. The assets of the Sub-Fund cannot be used to pay the debts of other sub-funds of the Fund.

## What are the costs?

The person advising on or selling you this product may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

### Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0 % annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.

(\*) This illustrates how costs reduce your return each year over the holding period. For example it shows that if you exit at the recommended holding period your average return per year is projected to be 9.6% before costs and 7.7% after costs.

We have classified this product as 4 out of 7, which is a medium risk class.

## How long should I hold it and can I take my money out early?

### Recommended holding period: 5 years.

The recommended holding period was chosen to provide a consistent return less dependent on market fluctuations.

Redemptions are possible each full business day. In the event this is not a business day, the valuation date will be the following business day. The share value for each valuation day is calculated on the following banking day ("calculation day") after the valuation day. A business day is a day on which banks in Luxembourg and Frankfurt am Main are normally opened for business, with the exception of 24 and 31 December of each year.

## How can I complain?
